First Aid & Emergency Info Directions & Parking

We have two parking locations; Main Stocking Lane Car Park and Stocking Lane 2.(See map location below)

Main Car Park:

As you approach on Stocking Lane:

- 1. Pass the cricket pitch on your right
- 2. Our entrance is immediately after the cricket ground

Stocking Lane 2 Car Park:

As you approach on Stocking Lane:

- 1. Pass the cricket pitch on your right and main Stocking Lane car park.
- 2. And about 200 yards on your left side is the Stocking Lane 2 Car Park.
- ## Parking is limited, so car sharing is encouraged.
- Park close and considerately—children will be present
- Overflow may be available at the cricket ground or along Chapel Street/Hillam Common Lane. Please respect local residents.
- Parking is at your own risk; the club accepts no liability for damage or theft.
